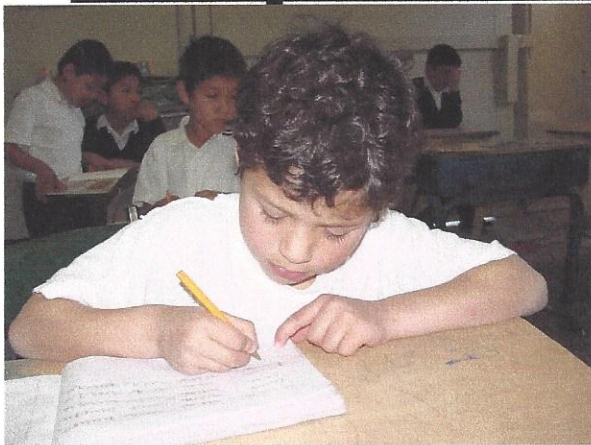


# TEAM CFCI TIJUANA / SD

It is hard to believe, but it is time to think "Back to School" for our Mexican children. School will be starting this month. This means we have over 90 boys to get ready and very soon! If you can identify with this, then you know that clothes, supplies, and inscription costs are needed in time to get these boys on their way. They also need prayer that they will travel safely back and forth from school to the orphanage, that they would be ready to learn and that they would adjust to the social pressures of being around other children.

## Back to School Time!

### School Supplies

- Pencils
- Pens (blue, black)
- Colored Pencils in packs of 12
- Pencil Sharpeners
- Erasers
- Geometry Sets-with ruler, triangles, protractor, compass
- Glue Sticks
- Spiral notebooks: lined, plain, graph
- Contact paper or book covers

In Tijuana, there are only half the number of schools that are needed so kids are split up into two sessions, morning and afternoon. You can imagine how hard it would be to organize 90 boys in this system. But amazingly, Eduardo Mendez, Orphanage Director, has all elementary school age boys from our two orphanages attending the same school in the same afternoon session. In the morning they are able to study, do their chores and have a Bible lesson. Education is so important in this 3rd world country. With it there is a chance for a better life.
